


BRIDGING THE GAP

One of the main challenges faced when reconstructing teeth, is accurately matching the shade of the natural dentition. The choice of light source in the clinic has a major impact on finding a matching shade.

Most dental clinics are fitted with either incandescent, fluorescent, halogen or LED lighting. Incandescent and halogen light sources emit a high concentration of yellow light waves, whereas fluorescent light sources emit large concentrations of blue waves. Unfortunately, despite their widespread usage, neither light source provides ideal conditions for matching shade. There are variations in the perceived hue and value of colour due to the added colour in the spectrum of the light emitted.

Natural daylight is considered the best light source, because it is close to emitting the full spectrum of white light. However, natural daylight has factors which can inhibit accurate shade comparison. The time of day, pollution, humidity and cloud coverage can filter or influence the distribution of light waves emitted from the sun.

An understanding of how the light source used affects the colour and colour perception is crucial to success in aesthetic restorative dentistry. Shade selection should be approached in a methodical and organized manner and coupled with the use of various light sources. While this process is time consuming, the result is an enhanced aesthetic result which ultimately benefits the patient and the dentist.
