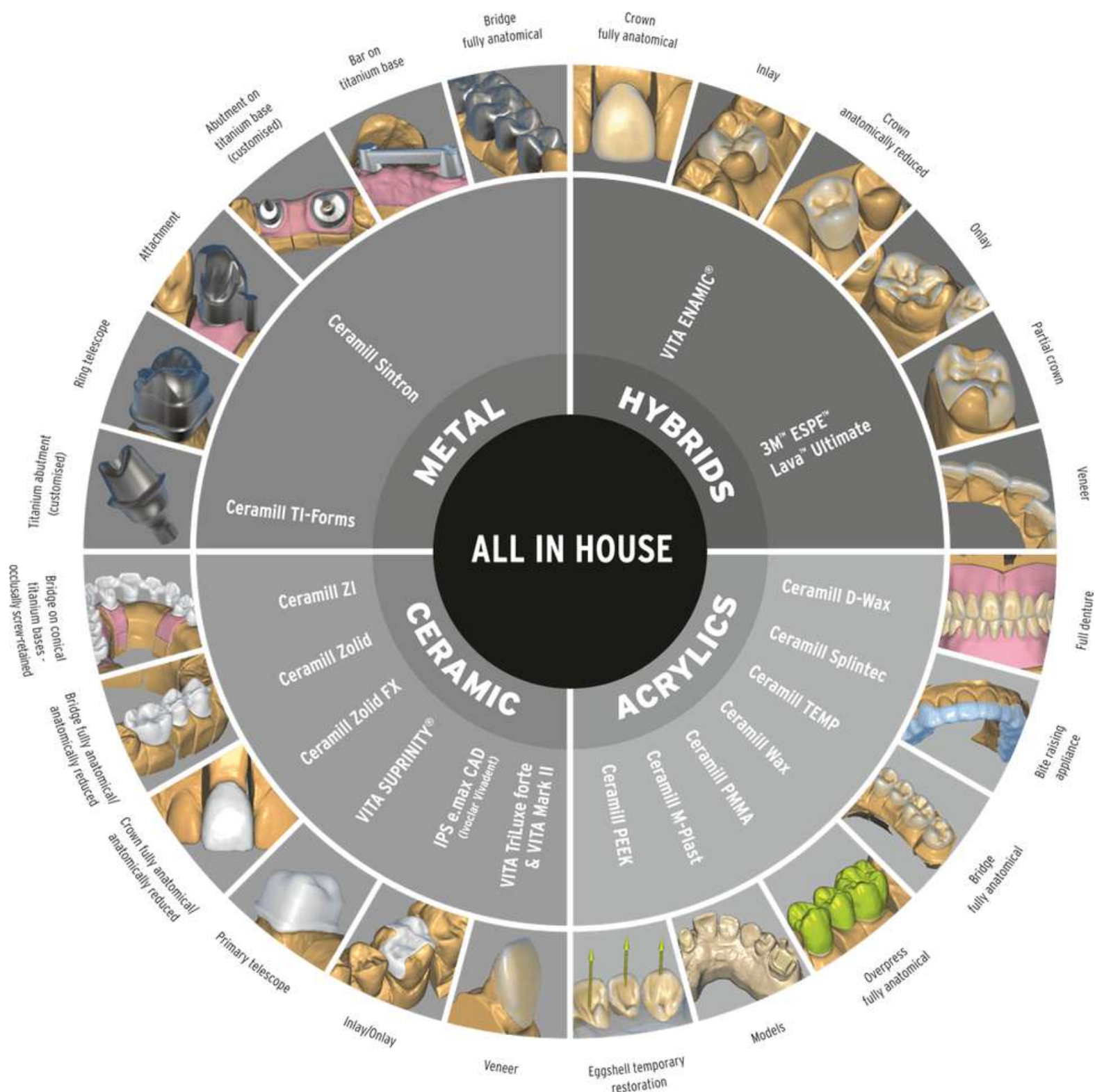


CONSIDERING GOING DIGITAL?

Future proofing against the rapid advancements in digital dentistry must also be given due consideration when purchasing a digital system.
